Ocean Literacy

The ocean is crucially important to the health of planet earth, yet public understanding of the ocean is superficial. *Telling Your Story* (TYS), a program of COSEE-New England, helps scientists and teachers increase ocean literacy by preparing them to create exciting K-12 classroom encounters in which scientists share the stories of their research, their careers, their institutions, and the crucial importance of the world's ocean. TYS helps scientists and teachers utilize the ancient art of story telling to engage students with ocean science, technology and research through direct interaction with a visiting ocean scientist.

Telling Your Story (TYS) Program

TYS begins with a one-day workshop at a university or research institution in which teachers and marine researchers learn how to make scientists' visits to classrooms inspirational, motivating, and informative for students. Following the workshop, teachers and



scientists work together to plan and conduct successful visits that may result in long term collaborations and extended interactions. Workshop staff follow up and monitor the collaborations as they develop.
